




and choreographed the show.

Synopsis and History



Legally Blonde: The Musical chronicles the journey of Elle Woods; a fashion savvy, UCLA sorority girl whose life is turned upside down when she is dumped by her boyfriend. Warner. In an effort to win Warner back, she enlists the help of her sorority sisters to follow him to Harvard Law School. However, Harvard is very different from her previous West Coast life, and Elle must deal with ruthless fellow students, terrifying Professors, and potentially disastrous hair decisions. Elle finds unlikely allies in dorky student Emmett, and hairdresser Paulette, and begins to understand what it takes to be a great lawyer. But when Elle is tasked with defending former Sorority girl Brooke Wyndham on a murder charge, Elle has to battle to stay true to herself. Can Elle win the case and win the man of her dreams?



Legally Blonde: The Musical is based on the 2001 film of the same name, starring Reese Witherspoon and Luke Wilson.


The musical opened on Broadway at the Palace Theatre in April 2007, starring Laura Bell Bundy as Elle Woods. It was nominated for seven Tony Awards, including Best Performance of a Leading Actress in a Musical for Laura Bell Bundy. The production then spawned a spin-off reality MTV show, looking for an actress to take over the leading role - which was eventually won by Bailey Hanks.

The West End production opened in 2010 at the Savoy Theatre, starring Sheridan Smith as Elle, and former Eastenders actress, Jill Halfpenny as Paulette. The London show won three Olivier Awards, including Best New Musical, and Best Actress in a Musical for Sheridan Smith. This all-American musical proved more popular in Britain than in the US. The show closed in London in 2012 after nearly 1000 performances significantly more than on Broadway. Legally Blonde has enjoyed huge success with audiences globally, with productions throughout Europe, as well as Australia, South Korea, the Philippines and Abu Dhabi.


