## SYNOPSIS

#### CLASSICAL MYTHOLOGY

Eurydice, beloved wife of Orpheus, is bitten by a snake and driven to Hades on her death-bed. Heart-broken Orpheus follows to plead for her to come back—and by his wonderful music charms the Deities of Hades to grant him one hope. He must return to earth with his adored wife following him, but if he should look back at her, Eurydice would disappear for ever. Orpheus attempts this but at the last moment, overwhelmed by his love for her, he turns to make sure she is near and loses her for ever.

#### OUR MYTHOLOGY

Orpheus and Eurydice have not been hitting it off in their marriage and are content to have their "little affairs," but unknown to Eurydice her lover of the moment, Aristaeus, is Pluto, King of the Underworld and carries her off to his cosy home in Hades. Orpheus, quite delighted that he is free at last, is bullied by his mother Calliope to keep to Classical Mythology and go to Mount Olympus to persuade Jupiter, King of the Gods, to get Eurydice back. With the help of all the various Gods and Godesses Jupiter sends for Pluto and insists on coming down to Hades himself to "view" the situation. Amongst the revels in Hades Eurydice, by now fed up with Pluto, has a quick flirtation with Jupiter who, when Calliope is adamant to carry out the old legend strikes poor Orpheus so hard that he has to turn round leaving Eurydice "fancy free" and everyone simply ecstatic.


