




CHAIR'S NOTE

SYNOPSIS

Movie musical 'Singin' in the Rain', beloved since the moment it premiered, was ranked as the fifth greatest motion picture of all time.

Now adapted for the stage, *Singin' in the Rain* "pours" down delight, capturing the waning days of the Silent Screen era, as they give way to new-fangled "talkies." With *The Jazz Singer* premiere making Hollywood frantic, the studios are forced to suddenly change all the moviemaking rules at once, to accommodate sound. In doing so, they leave silent pictures - and some of their stars - behind.

When Monumental Studios turns the silent *The Dueling Cavalier* into *The Dancing Cavalier*, a musical picture, in order to stay relevant, they are faced with a problem: their star, Lina Lamont, can't sing, and can't even really talk.

Lina's voice sounds something like nails on a chalkboard. Enter Kathy Selden, an aspiring actress whose dulcet tones are able to cover Lina Lamont's - calling into question what it means to act, how credit is distributed, and what it means to get a fair shake in the movie business. *Singin' in the Rain* includes some of the best-loved comedy routines, dance numbers, and love songs ever written, including "Good Mornin", "Make 'em Laugh," and, of course, the show-stopping dance number, "Singin' in the Rain".

HAPPY BIRTHDAY ELOD

In 1953, a group of like-minded friends got together to celebrate their love of theatre, music and performing. Initially known as The Wheatsheaf Players, and sponsored by The Co-Operative Society, the society's first contribution to the local theatre scene was Gilbert and Sullivan's Trial by Jury. The name was soon changed to Enfield Light Operatic and Dramatic Society. Throughout the 50s and 60s, there was a varied programme of G & S and Light Opera classics until the society took on the challenge of producing more modern musicals, starting with *The Gypsy Baron* in 1961. These days we tend to just call ourselves Elods, as we don't currently put on plays or operas!



In the early days, Elods performed at the much-loved Intimate Theatre in Palmers Green, working in a theatre with an incredible history. Members recall the joys of cramped dressing rooms down steep stairs, applying make-up beneath the stage and, of course, braving the elements by running outside to make an entrance stage right!

1989 saw the company move to the Millfield Theatre - a brand new custom-built theatre, complete with portacabins in the car park for chorus dressing rooms - there only being three principal-sized dressing rooms within the theatre itself. Oh, how we miss those cold rainy nights in November running from the portacabins to the stage door! Thankfully further dressing rooms were forthcoming - LUXURY! But still we had our "experiences" - not least the time that a runaway bed, complete with its three occupants, ended up with one corner in the orchestra pit! Thanks to the support of the member of the orchestra who valiantly shoved the bed back onto stage, the only injury sustained was a slightly crumpled trombone!

In 2005, ELODS moved to their current home at the Wyllyotts Theatre in Potters Bar, and today we are proud to be part of the thriving Amateur Theatre scene in the area.

For 37 years (more than half of ELODS' lifetime) we have been privileged to work under the baton of our resident MD, Mark Newport, whose prodigious skill and endless patience brings the very best from everyone involved. Thanks to his ministrations, and those of countless other talented creatives we have worked with over the years, ELODS is much greater than the sum of its parts. Friendship has always been at the heart of ELODS – a group of friends who put on shows together. As we move into our eighth decade ELODS is going strong!









"Can you write something about MDing ELODS for 37 years in 300 words?"... That's only 8.1 words per year! Here goes:

I first heard of ELODS whilst at the Royal Academy of Music, seeing their advert for an "Evening Class" rehearsal pianist for *Oklahoma* on our notice board - no Social Media in "those days"! I remember waiting at Bounds Green tube for a lift, on my first rehearsal night, from the infamous Mike Gilbert (a past Chair) and was just about to turn & head back down the escalator, as he was 30 minutes late, when I heard him calling my name & apologising because he had fallen asleep! Six weeks as a rehearsal pianist followed before I was promoted to being their MD, with the first show *The Mikado* being at the Intimate Theatre.

74 shows later...has certainly created many memories - inspiring Directors, outstanding performances, including, most importantly, a strong chorus, all supported by great choreography and set design. But at the heart of the company is the friendship and dedicated teamwork that 'is ELODS'.

I'm particularly indebted to Simon Murphy (former MD) who got me my first gig with Les Miserables and Sal Pearson (another past Chair) who introduced me to the likes of Tim Rice and Don Black. The 'Newports' (Louise and Beth often on stage and Kieran with me in the pit) have made so many friends over the years with countless ELODS social events. Certainly twice a year the show completely takes over our lives - but we wouldn't have it any other way!!!!

During show week itself, as the audience walk past the pit to leave the theatre, I sometimes hear "Wow, that was just like a West End show!"... Well, it's not quite, but it makes me proud to hear it!

Things don't always go as planned on stage with ELODS – or a West End Show – with props and furniture falling in the pit... and even on one occasion a member of the male chorus landing on top of the drums! A few wrong cues, cut lines and some mighty long vamps, all covered by our talented and loyal musicians in the band, so appreciated by the audience, and all of whom make my life as an MD much easier.

I know our band (who may be reading this during the dialogue!) all feel a part of the ELODS family, genuinely enjoying each other's company and respecting each other's musicianship. I think our shows are better because of that!

FYI - "It'll be alright on the night" is my least favourite phrase – but lets hope it is for you tonight.

Enjoy the show!







are pleased to be collaborating with Elods in this production of "Singin' in the Rain"


Our task was to recreate in Black and White a silent film sequence, true to the original film, using members of the cast on location in a private garden complete with props, costume, lights, cameras and sound.

The club was formed over seventy years ago in the age of 8mm Silent Film. Since then, videotape has come and moved on, and we now film digitally in colour and sound using Tascam, Camcorders, DSLR "Go Pros", Mobile phones and even Drones. Recordings are edited digitally on PC or MAC running premiere or final cut and are in high definition. Potters Bar FilmMakers currently has over thirty members from complete amateur to ex industry and meets on alternate Thursday evenings here at Wyllyotts (not January or August). We have tuition evenings, film appreciation sessions and run five competitions for members to enter, each on a different theme, during the year. We also enter and judge interclub competitions. There are two social events and a "Festival of Films" held in October when the public are invited to come and see some of the films we have made over the past year.
