'The Maid of the Mountains' was first produced at Daly's Theatre, London, with a cast headed by Jose Collins in 1917, where it achieved the run of 1,352 performances. It was toured continuously for the next ten years and has been played in every country in the world. It was revived by Emile Littler at the London Coliseum in 1942, and subsequently toured for several years without a break, playing to business hitherto unprecedented.
